
Holiday Placemat

(2) 12 1/2 x 22" pieces of light color fabric
1 piece of batting - 12 1/2 " x 22"
(2) 2 1/2 x WOF strips (for binding)
Water or Air Soluble pen
Ruler
Letter Templates (included)


- 1. Cut out letter templates on solid line.
- 2 Let's begin by marking some guide lines on the right side of 1 fabric rectangle. This will aid in centering the letters on the fabric. Measure 3" from the top and draw a line across the width of the fabric. Repeat this step from the bottom of the fabric. Fig. 1



3. Center your letter templates between the two lines as shown. Once your templates are in the position, trace around each letter with the water/air soluble pen. Fig. 2



- 4. Layer your backing, batting and top piece. Baste in your preferred method.
- 5. Free motion quilt in a small stippling pattern. <u>Do not</u> quilt inside the traced letters. You want the letters to be quilting free.



6. Bind in your desired method. Enjoy your placemat!
