# Lake House 

A Foundation Paper Piecing Quilt Pattern from Tiny Llama Quilts




Skill Level: Confident Beginner | Intermediate

## Cover Fabrics

This quilt uses nine different $1 / 2$ yard cuts of fabric in different colors or prints to create a scrappy look. All color fabrics in the cover quilt are from the Suzy Quilts Signature Pure Solids collection from Art Gallery Fabrics. Fabric colors used for the cover quilt are:

| $\square$ | Ginger (1) | $\square$ | Honeymoon (4) |  | Velvet (7) |

## Fabric Requirements

| Fabric Requirements: Yardage Version |  |

| Colors/Prints 1-9 | $1 / 2$ yard each |
| Background Fabric | 2 yards |
| Backing <br> $\left(4^{\prime \prime}\right.$ overage) | 4 yards |
| Binding <br> $\left(21 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right.$ strips) | $1 / 2$ yard |

Fabric Requirements: FQ Version
**This quilt can be made with fat quarters for maximum scrappiness. You will need 18 fat quarters in different colors/prints to make the fat quarter version.

Fabric requirements for background fabric, backing, and binding will be the same for both versions.

## Finished quilt size: $54 "$ x $60 "$

## Before You Begin

Read through the entire pattern before you start to avoid any surprises.
A $1 / 4$ " seam allowance is indicated throughout the pattern and is required for accurate piecing.
Fabric requirements are based on an assumption of a $42^{\prime \prime}$ width of fabric.
Abbreviations:

WOF = Width of Fabric
Rec \(=\) Rectangle
```

RST = Right Sides Together
Sq = Square

## Before You Begin Cont.

This pattern does not include written instructions on how to do the foundation paper piecing technique. There are many excellent resources available online that teach this technique. ## IMPORTANT:

Print settings: When printing FPP templates, be sure to print each page at Actual Size 100\%. Do not select "Print to fit" or "Fill Page".

With each template page that you print, be sure to measure the 1 " square with a quilt ruler to ensure that the square measures exactly one inch:


Each house block is divided into (4) parts. To complete one house block, piece each part separately and then combine them. Just follow the numbers, starting with 1A and ending with 17E. There are a total of (9) house blocks in this quilt and every house block is a different combination of colors.

When making a house block, it is important to remember that all of the A's should be the same color/print for that specific house block, all of the B's should be the same color/print for that specific house block, all of the C's should be the same color/print for that specific house block, and so on, as in each house block, the color A represents the sky, the color B represents the chimney, the color C represents the roof, etc.

**Attach piece 18F (foundation) to the bottom of the house to finish the block.

FQ's 1 - 9


Next, cut all of your B, C, and D pieces from the second stack of (9) fat quarters.

Cut your 2" $\times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$ star pieces from (2) of the (9) fat quarters in this stack
FQ's 10-18


7" strip
$7.5^{\prime \prime}$ strip

## Star Block Construction

## Background Fabric



Each star is made up of four (4) identical sections.
For all stars, sew the pieces in the order shown to the left, starting with 1 and ending with 3.


For the small stars, all of your cut pieces are the same dimensions ( $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$ ).

The diagram to the left shows the orientation of the cut pieces when putting each section together.

For the center (color/print), cut piece should be attached vertically.

Background fabric pieces should be attached horizontally.


Attach the two pairs as shown.

## 3.5" Star <br> Print 2 - Make 2



Instructions:
Cut along the dotted lines so that you have 4 pieces for each star.
Each printed page makes one star.

1 inch
Square

Be sure you are using the same color/print for each star (if that is your desired look).

Add each piece in order indicated, starting with 1 , then 2 , and then 3 . The order should go: 1 - background, 2 - color/print, 3 - background.
