


Underground Railroad BOM Month 7 Bowtie Block

Fabric Needed

Background: (8) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares Color 1: (2) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares Color 2: (2) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares Color 3: (2) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares Color 4: (2) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares ** To make all bowties one color, cut (8) 4 1/2" squares

Two at a time Half Square Triangles (HST)



1. Pair each 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" color square with a 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" background square, right sides together. (Fig. 1)


- 2. Draw a diagonal line on the back of all background squares. (Fig. 1)
- 3. Stitch 1/4" from the drawn line, on both sides. (Fig. 2)
- 4. Cut on the draw line. (Fig. 3)
- 5. Open and press toward the darker fabric. (Fig. 4)
- 6. Trim each HST to 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares.

7. Sew two same color HSTs together in pairs. Press seams open. You will have 2 sets of each color. (Fig. 5)






8. Sew two matching color units together. Press seams open. Fig. 6





8. Sew any two finished bowtie blocks together and press in direction of arrows. (Fig. 7)





9. Sew the two rows together. Fig. 8. Press. Your have completed your block bowtie block.
